- Connect COTA's fixed-route service to the Groveport Rickenbacker Employee Access Transit (GREAT) shuttle and other county connections, increasing mobility options for tens of thousands of employees
- Be equipped with a food pantry, daycare, community garden, educational center and even more features to support the region and its economic stability
- Be designed with sustainability in mind as an all-electric facility with a rain garden, electric charging locations and other eco-friendly features
