2. ETHICS TRAINING

Susan Willeke, Ohio Ethics Commission, provided annual ethics training for trustees.

4. <u>LEVY PLANNING</u>

Burges & Burges Consultants led a discussion on a 14-month timeline of actions that need to be taken and legal requirements which need to be satisfied by the Board, staff and levy campaign consultants for the planned November 16 levy renewal.

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5. TRANSIT SYSTEM REDESIGN

Mike Bradley, Vice President, Planning, gave a presentation on the Transit System Redesign (TSR). He said the new transit service network focuses on realigning COTA's transit service creating a more effective transportation system that reflects changes in major employment areas, entertainment venues, and activities centers creating an easier to understand network that reduces travel times with more consistent service throughout the week.

Burges Consultants divided attendees into small breakout groups to discuss 1) messaging to the community, 2) community impact, and 3) internal/external challenges as it relates to the TSR.
