COTA makes adjustments to its service three times a year in January, May and September. COTA's ongoing expansion program includes adding service hours in 2016. Service expansion includes service to new destinations, increased frequency of service on existing routes, and increased spans of service.

COTA is also in the process of implementing its Transit System Redesign (TSR). A comprehensive review of the system was performed in 2014 with the goal of improving the bus network to meet the changing needs of the region.
