## **COTA Reroutes Due to Nationwide Children's Hospital Columbus Marathon**

**COLUMBUS, OH**—Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) customers should expect major delays and reroutes in conjunction with the Nationwide Children's Hospital Columbus Marathon this weekend. Reroutes will begin Thurs., Oct. 12, and will last through the afternoon of Sun., Oct. 15.

Lines 71 & 73 will be rerouted in the afternoon only on Thurs., Oct. 12 and Fri., Oct. 13.

Lines 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, AirConnect & Night Owl will be rerouted on Sat., Oct. 14, beginning around 9:30 a.m.

The official start time of the race on Sunday is 7:30 a.m. However, reroutes will begin at the start of COTA service and run through mid-afternoon. Lines 1, 2, 2L, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 22, 31, CBUS® and AirConnect will be impacted. **All downtown stops will be closed beginning at 4 a.m., with the exception of pick-up locations at Long and 4<sup>th</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> and Spring.**
