## Dublin Public Comment Meeting Scheduled on January 28

**COLUMBUS**—In conjunction with the City of Dublin's Bridge St. District development efforts, the Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) and the City of Dublin staff continue to work together in order to relocate the Dale Drive Park & Ride with a goal of improving transit service to area residents. COTA will host a public comment meeting regarding proposed changes to service in Dublin. The proposed changes will impact Line 30 (Smoky Row), Line 58 (Dublin), and Line 59 (Dublin/Metro). The meeting will be held on:

The proposed changes include:

- Relocation of Dale Drive Park & Ride to Emerald Parkway/Bright Road
- Line 58 Dublin realignment
- Discontinue service on Riverside Green
- Line 59 Dublin/Metro realignment
- Discontinue service on Frantz Road
- Potential new Park & Ride in Avery-Muirfield/US-33 area
- In conjunction with the changes above, discontinue Line30 Smoky Row service
